A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS FOR KAWAIAHAO SCHOOL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds and declares that the 1 issuance of special purpose revenue bonds under this Act is in 2 the public interest and for the public health, safety, and 3 general welfare. 4 SECTION 2. Pursuant to part VIII, chapter 39A, Hawaii 5 Revised Statutes, the department of budget and finance, with the 6 approval of the governor, is authorized to issue special purpose 7 revenue bonds in a total amount not to exceed \$6,000,000, in one 8 or more series, for the purpose of assisting Kawaiahao School, a 9 Hawaii not-for-profit corporation, to finance the planning, 10 construction, and improvement of its educational facilities in 11 the State of Hawaii. The legislature hereby finds and 12 determines that the planning, construction, and improvement of 13

the facilities of Kawaiahao School constitute a project as

defined in part VIII, chapter 39A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and

the financing thereof is assistance to a not-for-profit private

- 1 June 30, 2011, to issue special purpose revenue bonds in
- 2 whatever principal amounts the department shall determine to be
- 3 necessary to refund the special purpose revenue bonds authorized
- 4 in section 2 and to refund special purpose revenue bonds

- 6 outstanding special purpose revenue bonds or refunding special
- 7 purpose revenue bonds have matured or are the subject of
