A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE HAWAII CONSTITUTION RELATING TO THE LEGISLATURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Article III, section 5, of the Constitution of 2 the State of Hawaii is amended to read as follows: 3 "VACANCIES 4 Section 5. Any vacancy in the legislature shall be filled 5 for the unexpired term in such manner as may be provided by 6 law[, or, if no provision be made by law, by appointment by the governor for the unexpired term.]; provided that the governor 7 shall fill a vacancy in the legislature by appointing a person 8 from a list of not less than six nominees for the vacancy, 9 10 presented to the governor by the judicial selection commission." SECTION 2. The question to be printed on the ballot shall 11 12 be as follows: 13 "Shall the governor be required to select a person for 14 a legislative vacancy from a list of six nominees 15 presented to the governor by the judicial selection 16 commission?"
