# A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR AN AGRICULTURAL PARK IN ROYAL KUNIA.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that expanding farm
- 2 opportunities in the state is essential for economic development
- 3 and sustainability. As the demand for urban land development
- 4 increases, it is vital that the need for agricultural lands be
- 5 addressed.
- 6 To further the expansion of agricultural lands in the
- 7 state, the department of agriculture has acquired one hundred
- 8 fifty acres of prime agricultural land in Royal Kunia and has
- 9 designated it be used for an agricultural park. The
- 10 agricultural park would serve as a buffer between the urban
- 11 lands in Kunia and the mauka agricultural lands. Furthermore,
- 12 the agricultural park would create a barrier with Kunia Road to
- 13 halt the advance of residential developments in the upper Pearl
- 14 Harbor saddle.
- 15 The legislature finds that the Royal Kunia agricultural
- 16 park will benefit both agricultural and urban land users and
- 17 seeks to support its development.

- 1 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation to the
- 2 department of agriculture to develop a master plan for an
- 3 agricultural park in Royal Kunia.
- 4 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 5 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$250,000 or so much
- $\mathbf{6}$  thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 for the
- 7 development of a master plan for an agricultural park in Royal
- 8 Kunia.
- 9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 10 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
