A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TELECOMMUNICATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to 3 read as follows: 4 "§46-Cellular phone antennas, towers, and structures; permitting process; public hearing. The counties shall enact 5 6 ordinances and prescribe rules and administrative procedures for the permitting of cell phone antennas, towers, and other 7 structures that exceed ten feet in height. The permitting 8 9 process shall require a public hearing on the application. 10 Notice for the public hearing shall include but not be limited 11 to requiring the applicant to mail a notice setting forth the 12 time and place of the public hearing to not less than two-thirds 13 of the owners and lessees of record of real estate and owners of 14 records of shares in a cooperative apartment or to those 15 individuals on the list of owners as provided by the managing 16 agent or governing body of the shareholders association situated 17 within a five hundred foot radius from the proposed location of

the cell tower, antenna, or structure."

5	emissions	testing. The department of health shall:

7		of radio frequency radiation from cellular base
8		station antennas and antenna towers throughout the
9		State; and
10	(2)	Detect and control conditions and exposures affecting
11		health that are associated with exposure to radio
12		frequency radiation emissions of cellular base station
13		antennas and antenna towers."
