A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 304-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:		
3	"(b) The board may charge resident and nonresident tuition		
4	fees for regular courses of instruction at any University of		
5	Hawaii campus, including any community college.		
6	The board may also charge other fees for special programs		
7	of instruction, as well as laboratory fees, course fees, fees		
8	for student activities, and an information technology user fee.		
9	The board may charge other fees for summer session or evening		
10	courses, including differential fees for nonresident students.		
11	The board may [waive]:		
12	$\underline{\text{(1)}}$ Waive entirely or reduce the tuition fee or any of the		
13	other fees for graduate teaching and research		
14	assistants[. The board may enter];		
15	(2) Enter into agreements with government and university		
16	officials of any other state or foreign country to		
17	provide for reciprocal waiver of the nonresident		
18	tuition and fee differential[. The board may waive];		

1	(3)	<u>Waive</u> the nonresident tuition and fee differential for	
2		selected students from Pacific and Asian jurisdictions	
3		when their presence would be beneficial to the	
4		university or the State[. The board may waive];	
5	(4)	<u>Waive</u> entirely or reduce the tuition fee or any of the	
6		other fees for students, resident or nonresident $[-]$:	
7		and	
8	(5)	Charge resident tuition fees for members of the Hawaii	
9		national guard and their authorized dependents,	
10		regardless of their actual state of residence.	
11	The board	shall determine the percentage of allowable tuition	
12	and fee w	aivers for financial need and other university	
13	prioritie	s. These tuition waivers and waivers of the	
14	nonresident tuition and fee differential shall be awarded in		
15	accordanc	e with guidelines established by the board."
