A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS TO ASSIST ROSETTE STEEL HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds and declares that the
- 2 issuance of special purpose revenue bonds under this Act is in
- 3 the public interest and for the public health, safety, and
- 4 general welfare.
- 5 SECTION 2. Pursuant to part III, chapter 39A, Hawaii
- 6 Revised Statutes, the department of budget and finance, with the
- 7 approval of the governor, is authorized to issue special purpose
- 8 revenue bonds in a total amount not to exceed \$10,000,000, in
- 9 one or more series, for the purpose of assisting Rosette Steel
- 10 Hawaii, a Hawaii corporation, with technology-based
- 11 manufacturing of steel products for the construction industry to
- 12 assist in the development of affordable housing in Hawaii. The
- 13 legislature hereby finds and determines that the manufacture of
- 14 steel products constitutes a project as defined in part III,
- 15 chapter 39A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and the financing thereof
- 16 is assistance to a manufacturing enterprise.

- SECTION 3. The special purpose revenue bonds and the 1 refunding special purpose revenue bonds issued under this Act 2 shall be issued pursuant to part III, chapter 39A, Hawaii 3 Revised Statutes, relating to the power to issue special purpose 4 revenue bonds to assist manufacturing enterprises. 5 SECTION 4. The department of budget and finance is 6 authorized, from time to time, including times subsequent to 7 June 30, 2011, to issue special purpose revenue bonds in 8 whatever principal amounts the department shall determine to be 9 necessary to refund the special purpose revenue bonds authorized 10 in section 2 and to refund special purpose revenue bonds 11 authorized in this section, regardless of whether the 12 outstanding special purpose revenue bonds or refunding special 13 purpose revenue bonds have matured or are the subject of 14 redemption or whether the refunding special purpose revenue 15 bonds shall be bonds for the multi-project programs described in 16 section 2. In making this determination, the department shall 17 comply with federal law relating to the exemption from federal 18 income taxation of the interest on bonds of the nature 19 authorized by this section. 20
- 21 SECTION 5. The authorization to issue special purpose 22 revenue bonds under this Act shall lapse on June 30, 2011.

1 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
