A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CIVIL DEFENSE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that pets enrich our 1 lives in more ways than we sometimes realize. In turn, they 2 depend on us for their safety and well-being. In times of 3 natural disaster, both humans and animals, particularly pet 4 animals, are in danger of loss of life or serious injury. 5 However, the legislature finds that, during a civil defense 6 emergency period, most emergency shelters will not accept pet 7 animals due to public health concerns. 8 The legislature is concerned with the welfare of pet 9 animals during emergencies; however, of equal concern is the 10 fact that many pet owners, worried about their pets' safety, may 11 be dissuaded or delayed in seeking proper shelter in these 12 emergencies. As recent events have shown, many pet owners would 13 put themselves in harm's way rather than abandon their pets. 14 The purpose of this Act is to direct the director of civil 15 defense and organizations under the direction of the director of 16 civil defense that operate and maintain emergency shelters 17 during civil defense emergency periods, subject to the public's 18

- 1 health and safety, to make suitable arrangements and
- 2 accommodations to provide shelter to pet animals.
- 3 SECTION 2. Chapter 128, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 4 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 5 and to read as follows:
- 6 "\$128- Public shelters; accommodation of pet animals.
- 7 (a) The governor shall prescribe rules, pursuant to section
- 8 128-27, for the purpose of establishing the criteria,
- 9 requirements, conditions, and limitations for providing suitable
- 10 arrangements and accommodations for the sheltering of pet
- 11 animals in public shelters under this chapter.
- 12 (b) The director shall identify, in coordination with
- 13 other organizations engaged in civil defense functions relating
- 14 to providing shelter, or the management or operation of a public
- 15 shelter under this chapter, those public shelters that are
- suitable for the sheltering of pet animals.
- (c) The director may also identify, in coordination with
- 18 private owners, operators, or controllers of real property,
- 19 private shelters that are suitable for the sheltering of pet
- 20 animals; provided that any private shelter so identified shall
- 21 not be subject to the rules prescribed by the director for the

- 1 operation of a public shelter that has been identified for the
- 2 sheltering of pet animals pursuant to subsection (b).
- 3 (d) A public shelter identified for the sheltering of pet
- 4 animals pursuant to subsection (b) need not be subject to the
- 5 criteria developed pursuant to Act 5, Special Session Laws of
- 6 Hawaii 2005, unless the particular shelter has been specifically
- 7 identified as a shelter for both pet animals and the public.
- 8 (e) For purposes of this section, "pet animal" shall have
- 9 the same meaning as defined in section 711-1100."
- 10 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Civil Defense; Shelters.

Description:

Directs Director of Civil Defense to establish criteria, rules, and conditions for providing emergency shelters for pet animals and to identify public shelters suitable for sheltering pet animals; and may identify private shelters that are also suitable for sheltering pet animals. (HB3121 HD1)
