BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

8	(b)	An a	pplicant under this section shall submit all of			
9	the follo	wing	to the board:			
10	(1)	A co	mpleted application and all required fees; and			
11	(2)	<u>Veri</u>	fication:			
12		(A)	Of graduation from a general dental education			
13			program accredited by the American Dental			
14			Association Commission on Dental Accreditation or			
15			the Commission on Dental Accreditation of Canada;			
16		(B)	Of graduation from a post-graduate specialty			
17			program accredited by the American Dental			
18			Association Commission on Dental Accreditation;			

1	<u>(C)</u>	Of a current active license issued by another
2		state that is not revoked, suspended, or
3		otherwise restricted;
4	(D)	That the applicant has been lawfully engaged in
5		the practice of dentistry for at least three
6		years preceding the date of the application, with
7		a minimum of one thousand hours of dentistry
8		practice each year; provided that the applicant
9		may receive credit for two of the three years of
10		clinical practice by demonstrating completion of
11		a specialty residency training program accredited
12		by the American Dental Association Commission on
13		Dental Accreditation;
14	<u>(E)</u>	Of completion of a minimum of thirty-two hours of
15		continuing education in the applicant's dental
16		specialty within the preceding two-year period;
17	<u>(F)</u>	That the applicant has not been subject to
18		disciplinary action by any jurisdiction in which
19		the applicant is or has been previously licensed
20		to practice dentistry; provided that if the
21		applicant has been subject to disciplinary
22		action, the board shall review that action to

1		determine if it warrants refusal to issue a
2		license to the applicant;
3	<u>(G)</u>	That the applicant has no felony convictions of
4		any kind and no other criminal convictions that
5		may affect the applicant's ability to render
6		competent dental care;
7	<u>(H)</u>	Of registration status with the federal Drug
8		Enforcement Administration and a self-query
9		report from the National Practitioner Data Bank;
10		provided that the board shall review this
11		information to determine if it warrants refusal
12		to issue a license to the applicant; and
13	<u>(I)</u>	Of passage of parts I and II of the National
14		Board Dental Examination.
15	No person who	has failed to pass the dentistry licensure
16	examination sh	all have the benefit of a community service
17	license.	
18	(c) Comm	unity service licensees shall actively participate
19	in a formal an	d ongoing program of clinical quality assurance.
20	(d) A li	cense may be renewed annually, pending review and
21	reauthorizatio	n of the board of dental examiners. Renewal

1	requests	shall be submitted to the board of dental examiners			
2	sixty days prior to expiration.				
3	(e)	The community service license shall authorize the			
4	licensee	to practice a dental specialty only within the			
5	employmen.	t of an eligible organization and shall be in force			
6	until the	earliest of the following occurs:			
7	(1)	The date the person leaves the employment authorized			
8		under the community service license;			
9	(2)	The date on which the results of the licensure			
10		examination taken by the person under this chapter are			
11		posted by the board; or			
12	(3)	The date on which the board revokes the community			
13		service license; provided that the board may revoke			
14		the community service license at any time for cause.			
15	<u>(f)</u>	As used in this section:			
16	"Den	tal specialties" means orthodontics, endodontics,			
17	pedodontio	cs, periodontics, oral surgery, oral radiology, public			
18	health de	ntistry, or oral medicine/oral pathology.			
19	<u>"</u> Qua	lified applicant" means any person who meets all the			
20	requireme	nts set forth in subsection (b).			
21	"Qualified place of employment" means a federally qualified				
22	health ce	nter, native Hawaiian health systems center, or a
