A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that student exchange
2	programs involving students in Hawaii's schools provide the
3	opportunity to learn first-hand the cultures of other countries
4	of the world. These exchanges foster and sustain good
5	relationships and cultural interaction between foreign countries
6	and the State of Hawaii. The State currently has a student
7	exchange program with Japan's Okinawa prefecture, which has
8	demonstrated the benefits and cost-effectiveness of these
9	programs over its fifteen-year existence.
10	Implementing a similar student-and-faculty exchange program
11	between the State and its sister provinces in the Republic of
12	the Philippines would provide a more concrete and viable
13	connection between the State and those provinces than a mere
14	relationship on paper. Officials in the Republic of the
15	Philippines have expressed a strong interest in developing
16	student exchange programs. The establishment of such a program
17	at this time would be particularly appropriate since this year
18	marks the Filipino Centennial Celebration, the one-hundredth

- 1 anniversary of the arrival of Filipinos to Hawaii that honors
- 2 the achievements and contributions Filipinos have made to the
- 3 state. Hawaii and the Philippines have a long history of close
- 4 relations and connections. A student-and-faculty exchange
- 5 program between Hawaii and the Philippines would strengthen an
- 6 already close cultural, social, and economic relationship
- 7 between the State and the Philippines.
- 8 SECTION 2. The department of education, in consultation
- 9 with the Hawaii Association of Independent Schools and the
- 10 University of Hawaii, shall develop a student and faculty
- 11 exchange program with the State's sister provinces in the
- 12 Republic of the Philippines involving public and private schools
- 13 in Hawaii and students and faculty in schools in the
- 14 Philippines. The department shall also consult with the various
- 15 Filipino communities and organizations in the planning and
- 16 implementation of the exchange program. The program shall be
- 17 implemented by the beginning of the 2008-2009 school year.
- 18 SECTION 3. The department shall submit a report to the
- 19 legislature of its findings and recommendations on the creation,
- 20 implementation, and maintenance of a student-and-faculty
- 21 exchange program between Hawaii and the State's sister provinces
- 22 in the Republic of the Philippines no later then twenty days

- 1 prior to the convening of the regular session of 2007 and 2008,
- 2 if necessary to update the legislature on the status of the
- 3 program's intended implementation.
- 4 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 5 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- $\mathbf{6}$ thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 to develop
- 7 and implement a student-and-faculty exchange program with the
- 8 State's sister provinces in the Republic of the Philippines
- 9 involving public and private schools in Hawaii and students and
- 10 faculty in schools in the Philippines.
- 11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 12 education for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.

Education; Student-and-Faculty Exchange Program with Philippines

Description:

Directs the department of education, in consultation with a variety of other organizations, to develop and implement a student-and-faculty exchange program between Hawaii and the Philippines. (HB3258 HD1)
