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HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DIRECTOR OF COMMERCE AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS TO CONVENE A TASK FORCE TO CONSIDER THE REGULATION OF MORTGAGE BROKERS AND SOLICITORS BY THE DIVISION OF FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS.

WHEREAS, mortgage brokers and solicitors are currently regulated by the Professional and Vocational Licensing Division and the Regulated Industry Complaints Office of the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Financial Institutions of the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs regulates all other aspects of the mortgage lending and banking industry; and

WHEREAS, the transfer of the regulatory control of the mortgage brokers and solicitors to the Division of Financial Institutions would place all aspects of the mortgage lending industry under one regulatory body; and

WHEREAS, regulation under a single regulatory body will promote fairness and efficiency in governmental operations; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2006, the Senate concurring, that the Director of Commerce and Consumer Affairs is requested to convene a Task Force to consider:

- (1) Whether there should be a transfer of the regulation of mortgage brokers and solicitors to the Division of Financial Institutions;
- (2) The regulatory scheme to be employed if a transfer is recommended; and
