## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ALOHA SPIRIT.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 5-7.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 2 In exercising their power on behalf of the people and 3 in fulfillment of their responsibilities, obligations, and 4 service to the people, the legislature, governor, lieutenant 5 governor, executive officers of each department, the chief 6 justice, associate justices, and judges of the appellate, 7 circuit, and district courts may contemplate and reside with the 8 life force and give consideration to the "Aloha Spirit" [-]\_ 9 steadfastly asking and contemplating with each of their actions, 10 including what they think, do, say, or decide, whether that 11 12 action: (1) Is the truth; 13 (2) Is fair to all concerned; 14 (3) Will build good will and better relationships; and 15 Will be beneficial to all concerned." 16 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 18

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
