BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 171-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended to read as follows: 2 "§171-13 Disposition of public lands. (a) Except as 3 provided in subsection (b) and as otherwise provided by law, and 4 subject to other provisions of this chapter, the board may: 5 Dispose of public land in fee simple, by lease, lease 6 (1)with option to purchase, license, or permit; and Grant easement by direct negotiation or otherwise for (2) particular purposes in perpetuity on such terms as may 9 be set by the board, subject to reverter to the State 10 upon termination or abandonment of the specific 11 purpose for which it was granted, provided the sale 12 price of such easement shall be determined pursuant to 13 section 171-17(b). 14 No person shall be eligible to purchase or lease public lands, 15 or to be granted a license, permit, or easement covering public 16 lands, who has had during the five years preceding the date of 17 disposition a previous sale, lease, license, permit, or easement 18
