# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO A COMMISSION ON FATHERHOOD.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 2 of Act 156, Session Laws of Hawaii
2	2003, as amended by Act 148, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, is
3	amended by amending subsection (a) of section -3 to read as
4	follows:
5	"(a) The commission shall consist of [fifteen] sixteen
6	members and reflect the geographic and cultural diversity of the
7	[State.] state. The membership shall include:
8	(1) Ex officio, the director of human services,
9	superintendent of education, director of health,
10	attorney general, [director of the office of children
11	and youth, director of public safety, an
12	administrator of the family courts, and executive
13	director of the office of youth services, or their
14	designees; [ <del>and</del> ]
15	(2) Eight voting members shall be appointed by the
16	governor as provided in section 26-34, except as
17	otherwise provided in this section, as follows:

1		(A)	Two members shall be appointed by the governor	
2			from a list of three nominees submitted by the	
3			president of the senate, and two members shall be	
4			appointed by the governor from a list of three	
5			nominees submitted by the speaker of the house of	
6			representatives; and	
7		(B)	Four members shall be appointed by the governor	
8			from the community $[\cdot]$ :	
9		and		
10	(3)	One	voting member shall be designated by the Hawaii	
11		Coal	ition for Dads."	
12	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed			
13	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.			
14	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2096.

### Report Title:

Commission on Fatherhood; Membership

### Description:

Replaces the Director of the Office of Children and Youth with: (1) the Director of Public Safety or designee; and (2) an administrator of the Family Court or designee, as members of the Commission on Fatherhood. Effective date July 1, 2096. (SB2188 HD2)
