A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE COMMISSION ON FATHERHOOD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

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1	SECTION 1. Recognizing the important and unique role		
2	fathers play in the lives of their children, families, and		
3	communities, the legislature established the Hawaii commission		
4	on fatherhood in 2003. Act 156, Session Laws of Hawaii 2003,		
5	directs the commission to serve in an advisory capacity to state		
6	agencies to promote healthy family relationships between parents		
7	and children. The commission is authorized to make		
8	recommendations on programs, services, and contracts relating to		
9	children and families. The commission is attached to the		
10	department of human services for administrative purposes.		
11	To implement its strategic plan and fulfill its		
12	responsibilities, the commission must hire an executive director		
13	and staff to:		
14	(1) Complete a statewide analysis of service provision to		
15	fathers;		
16	(2) Develop policy recommendations on best practices for		
17	serving fathers via state agencies and their service		
18	providers;		

1	(3)	Develop, support, and advocate for legislation that	
2		facilitates father involvement in the lives of	
3		children;	
4	(4)	Issue an annual report on the status of fatherhood	
5		issues in Hawaii;	
6	(5)	Operate year-round public awareness campaigns about	
7		the importance of father involvement in the lives of	
8		children;	
9	(6)	Make available information and resources related to	
10		effective fathering and parenting support to fathers	
11		and families;	
12	(7)	Present the annual Parent-Friendly Business Award; and	
13	(8)	Administer appropriated funds, seek and leverage funds	
14		from other sources, and award grants to other	
15		organizations.	
16	The p	urpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the	
17	state comm	ission of fatherhood.	
18	SECTI	ON 2. There is appropriated out of the general	
19	revenues o	f the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much	
20	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 for the		
21	state commission on fatherhood to hire an executive director and		
22	staff to c	arry out the purposes of this Act.	

- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 2 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
