A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE MAKENA-KEONEOIO GOVERNMENT ROAD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that in June 1973, the 1
- Ahihi-Kinau area on Maui's southwest flank, which contains the 2
- most recent lava flow from Haleakala, became the first 3
- designated natural area reserve in the state. The reserve 4
- contains numerous ancient Hawaiian archaeological and cultural 5
- sites; fragile anchialine ponds, containing endangered endemic 6
- aquatic species; and isolated coves, small bays, and coral 7
- reefs, containing numerous species of marine fauna, including
- fish, crustaceans, corals, and aquatic vegetation. 9
- The Makena-Keoneoio government road that traverses the 10
- reserve permits uncontrolled public access to the reserve. 11
- Further, publicity of the reserve and its many resources in 12
- travel books and journals is attracting hundreds of visitors 13
- from all over the world to the reserve every day. This influx 14
- of visitors is having an enormous negative impact on the reserve 15
- 16 and its resources.
- The purpose of this Act is to direct the department of land 17
- and natural resources to provide limited access to the 18

3	SECTION 2. Chapter 195, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
5	and to read as follows:
6	"§195- Ahihi-Kinau natural area reserve; Makena-Keoneoio
7	government road. (a) The department of land and natural
8	resources shall develop rules in accordance with chapter 91 to
9	prohibit public access to the Makena-Keoneoio government road
10	where it traverses the Ahihi-Kinau natural area reserve.
11	(b) Access to the portion of the Makena-Keoneoio
12	government road that is closed to public access shall be limited
13	to the following:
14	(1) Legal residents of the area who require access to
15	their residences;
16	(2) State and county officials and employees who require
17	access to maintain the road and the reserve and its
18	resources; and
19	(3) Persons who are permitted into the reserve pursuant to
20	administrative rules adopted by the department of land
21	and natural resources."
