A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SAGE PLUS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The Sage PLUS program provides assistance at no
- 2 charge to people receiving medicare and medicaid benefits, as
- 3 well as their families, caregivers, and people on the verge of
- 4 retirement.
- 5 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for
- 6 operating costs to expand and support the Sage PLUS program on
- 7 the neighbor islands.
- 8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$104,000 or so much
- 10 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 for
- 11 operation and delivery of the Sage PLUS program on the neighbor
- 12 islands.
- 13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 14 health for the purposes of this section.
- 15 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$64,500 or so much
- 17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 for the
- 18 recruitment, training, and sustaining of volunteers to augment



- 1 the Sage PLUS program staff, and for operating costs of the
- 2 neighbor island Sage PLUS program staff.
- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 4 health for the purposes of this section.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
