BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 606-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: "§606-3 Seal of court[7]; physical or electronic seal, 3 4 signature, or attestation[-] on physical or electronic court 5 records. (a) Each court of record shall have a seal, [the 6 device of which shall be as approved by the supreme court. 7 seal shall be in the custody or control of the clerk of the 8 $court[\tau]$ and $[\frac{shall be}{}]$, when impressed, embossed, stamped, or 9 electronically imprinted upon [all processes and official 10 certificates,] a court document, process, or certificate, shall 11 be accompanied by the clerk's official attestation. 12 (b) Any requirement that a court document, process, or 13 certificate shall be signed, certified, acknowledged, verified, 14 exemplified, attested, or made under oath or seal is satisfied 15 if the document bears an electronic seal of the court and an 16 electronic image of the signature or electronic facsimile

- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
