A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Developmental disabilities residential service
- providers provide important residential care services for 2
- individuals with developmental disabilities or mental 3
- retardation. Presently, the providers of these services are not 4
- being adequately reimbursed by the State for the high-quality, 5
- community-based residential services they provide to these 6
- individuals. As a result, in the last several years providers 7
- were forced to close at least nine community-based developmental 8
- disabilities residences due to a lack of funding. 9
- probable that many more of these residential options will be 10
- closed if adequate funding is not provided. This situation 11
- would deny hundreds of persons with developmental disabilities 12
- 13 viable and proven successful community-based residential
- options. Furthermore, it would aggravate the severe shortage of 14
- housing for low-income persons, especially those with 15
- developmental disabilities. Without the necessary funding, many 16
- viable residential options now operating are likely to close and 17
- 18 be lost to the state.

- 1 The legislature enacted Act 168, Session Laws of Hawaii
- 2 (SLH) 2005 (Act 168), authorizing the department of health to
- 3 enter into contracts for additional payments for residential
- 4 services to the providers of developmental disabilities
- 5 domiciliary homes and operators of developmental disabilities
- 6 apartment complexes. Act 236, SLH 2005, appropriated \$485,000
- 7 for fiscal year 2005-2006 to implement Act 168; however, no
- f 8 funds have been appropriated for fiscal year 2006-2007 for this
- 9 purpose.
- 10 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the
- 11 maintenance and operations of developmental disabilities
- 12 domiciliary homes and apartment complexes.
- SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 to provide
- 16 for continued operation of developmental disabilities
- 17 domiciliary homes and apartment complexes for persons with
- 18 developmental disabilities.
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 20 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
