RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

12	(a) Procurements of	less than [\$25,000] <u>\$50,000</u> for goods,	
13	services, or construction shall be made in accordance with		
14	procedures set forth in rules adopted by the policy board that		
15	are designed to ensure administrative simplicity and as much		
16	competition as is practicable; provided that multiple		
17	expenditures shall not be created at the inception of a		
18	transaction or project so as to evade the requirements of this		
19	chapter; and provided further that procurement requirements		
20	shall not be artificially divided or parceled so as to		
21	constitute a small purchase under this section.		

- 1 (b) Procurements of \$25,000 to less than \$50,000 shall be
- 2 made in accordance with small purchase procedures; provided that
- 3 small purchase procurements through an electronic system shall
- 4 be required after the policy board has adopted rules for

- 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon approval;
- 10 provided that section 2(b) shall take effect on July 1, 2007 or
- 11 upon the adoption of rules issued by the policy board for all
- 12 agencies subject to Chapter 103D, whichever occurs first. The
- 13 policy board shall immediately inform the revisor of statutes
- 14 upon the adoption of such rules.

Gives the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation (HHSC) more autonomy regarding procurement matters by designating the chief executive officer of HHSC as the chief procurement officer. Raises the amount for which a purchase may qualify as a small purchase from \$25,000 to less than \$50,000. (CD1)
