A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE LAND USE COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 205-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "\$205-1 Establishment of the commission. There shall be a state land use commission, hereinafter called the commission. 4 5 The commission shall consist of nine members who shall hold no 6 other public office and shall be appointed in the manner and serve for the term set forth in section 26-34. One member shall 7 8 be appointed from each of the counties and the remainder shall 9 be appointed at large [-]; provided that one member shall have 10 substantial experience or expertise in traditional Hawaiian land 11 usage and knowledge of cultural land practices that may be 12 evidenced, among other qualifications, by the member's status as 13 a: 14 (1)Native Hawaiian kupuna or elder; 15 (2) Native Hawaiian kahuna or keeper of sacred principles; 16 (3) Traditional cultural expert; (4) Practitioner of native Hawaiian land uses; or 17
