A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR CHORE SERVICE PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- ${f 1}$ SECTION 1. The legislature finds that our elderly and
- 2 disabled populations need assistance with household chores.
- 3 However, many residents do not have friends or family to assist
- 4 them with these routine tasks. Chore services programs enable
- 5 these residents to remain in their homes after they can no
- 6 longer perform essential housekeeping and related activities,
- 7 thereby avoiding premature and costly institutionalization.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation for
- 9 chore services programs.
- 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 for the
- 13 purpose of supporting and expanding the chore services program
- 14 to provide high quality elder care and services to Hawaii's
- 15 elderly and disabled populations.

- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 2 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
