A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 846-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

 amended by adding two new definitions to be appropriately

 inserted and to read as follows:

 ""Criminal history record check" refers to a search by name

 using the state computerized criminal history record information
- 6 system and by fingerprints using the state automated fingerprint
- 7 identification system.
- 8 "Criminal history record name inquiry" refers to a search
- 9 by name, and other identifying information, using the state
- 10 computerized criminal history record information system."
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 846-10.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 "S846-10.5 Fees. (a) Except for services provided to
- 14 criminal justice agencies and state or county agencies for
- 15 employment purposes, the Hawaii criminal justice data center and
- 16 state and county criminal justice agencies shall assess the
- 17 following fees for services provided or to be provided, which

15		fingerprint files, \$25;

18	[(5)]	(4) For certification of documents, \$10 per document;
19	[-(6)]	(5) For each duplicate expungement certificate
20		requested, \$15; and
21	[(7)]	(6) For each complete set of fingerprints taken, \$15.

- 1 (b) Criminal history record checks mandated for child care
- 2 facilities shall be exempt from the requirement to pay fees.
- 3 (c) Nonprofit charitable organizations that are tax-exempt
- 4 under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) shall be exempt
- 5 from fees for criminal history record checks conducted on adult
- 6 volunteers having direct contact with minors[-], the elderly, or
- 7 the disabled.
- 8 (d) Any other law to the contrary notwithstanding, the
- 9 data center may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 to establish
- 10 reasonable fees for services provided by the data center and to
- 11 establish other exemptions from the requirement to pay fees."

Description:

Provides a single fee for criminal history record checks by name, fingerprints, and other identifying information conducted by the Hawaii Criminal Justice Data Center and other state and county agencies. Updates the fee schedule for criminal history record check services to include criminal history record checks done via the Internet. Extends the fee exemption to include nonprofit charitable organizations for criminal history record checks conducted on adult volunteers having direct contact with the elderly and disabled.
