A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LIMU MANAGEMENT AREA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the natural supply of limu along the shores in Ewa beach is rapidly diminishing.
- 3 This is due in part to overharvesting of limu during the past
- 4 four years. As a result, many types of limu, including huluhulu
- 5 waenae, lipoa, and 'a'ala 'ula, can no longer be found or are at
- 6 risk of extinction in this area.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to preserve and sustain the limu
- 8 supply by establishing a limu management area along the
- 9 shoreline of Ewa beach on Oahu.
- 10 SECTION 2. Chapter 188, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 12 and to read as follows:
- 13 "\$188- Limu management area. (a) There is established
- 14 a limu management area from the shoreline and extending one
- 15 hundred fifty feet seaward in Ewa beach from the gunnery range
- 16 to the boat ramp on Muumuu street.
- 17 (b) No person, including a person with a commercial
- 18 fishing license, shall pick, gather, harvest, or otherwise take



- 1 limu from within the limu management area for two years
- 2 beginning on July 1, 2005; provided that this section shall not
- 3 apply to a person who has obtained a special permit to pick limu
- 4 for purposes of replanting.
- 5 (c) Beginning July 1, 2007, a person, including a person
- 6 with a commercial fishing license, may hand-pick limu in the
- 7 limu management area from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., only during
- 8 the months of December, January, and June of each year. A
- 9 maximum of one pound for all types of limu combined may be hand-
- 10 picked per day by any person, including any person possessing a
- 11 commercial fishing license."
- 12 SECTION 3. There shall be established an advisory group to
- 13 assist the department of land and natural resources in
- 14 determining the best management practices for conservation and
- 15 restoration of the limu management area.
- 16 The advisory group shall consist of members from the Limu
- 17 Project, The Nature Conservancy, and other community
- 18 organizations and members of the public.
- 19 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 20 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on December 31,
- 21 2007; provided that this Act shall be repealed on June 30, 2010.
