RELATING TO PUBLIC UTILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 269-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 2 The chairperson of the public utilities commission 3 may appoint and employ [such] clerks, stenographers, agents, 4 engineers, accountants, and other assistants for the public 5 utilities commission as the chairperson finds necessary for the 6 performance of the commission's functions and define their 7 powers and duties. The chairperson may appoint, and at 8 pleasure, dismiss a chief administrator, research assistants, 9 economists, legal secretaries, enforcement officers, utility 10 analysts, legal assistants, and [such] hearings officers as may 11 be necessary.
