A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 291, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 2 3 and to read as follows: 4 "§291-Rearview cameras. (a) All motor vehicles with 5 a gross vehicular weight rating equal to or greater than six 6 thousand pounds shall be equipped with a rearview camera. 7 (b) Any legal or registered owner of the motor vehicle who violates this section or rules adopted by the director of 8 9 transportation pursuant to this section shall be fined not more 10 than \$100. 11 (c) The director of transportation may adopt rules under 12 chapter 91 necessary to carry out this section. 13 (d) For the purposes of this section, "rearview camera" 14 means an apparatus mounted to the rear of the vehicle that 15 includes a video screen within the cab of the motor vehicle that 16 permits viewing of traffic conditions to the rear of a motor

vehicle."
