A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE HAWAII CONSTITUTION RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an amendment to article X, section 2, of the Constitution of the 2 3 State of Hawaii to require: 4 (1) The board of education to be composed of seventeen 5 voting members elected in a nonpartisan manner by the qualified voters of the respective school board 6 districts, as provided by law; and 7 (2) Each school board district to be composed of three 8 9 representative districts. 10 SECTION 2. Article X, section 2, of the Constitution of the State of Hawaii is amended to read as follows: 11 "BOARD OF EDUCATION 12 13 Section 2. There shall be a board of education composed of 14 seventeen voting members who shall be elected in a nonpartisan 15 manner by the qualified voters [, as provided by law, from two at-large school board districts. The first school board 16 17 district shall be comprised of the island of Oahu and all other
