A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FERRETS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 150A-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended t	o read as follows:

4	possessio	n prohibited. No person shall transport, receive for
5	transport	, or cause to be transported to the State, for the
6	purpose o	f debarkation or entry thereinto, any of the following
7	(1)	Soil; provided that limited quantities of soil may be
8		imported into the State for experimental or other
9		scientific purposes under permit with conditions
10		prescribed by the department;
11	(2)	Rocks, plants, plant products, or any article with
12		soil adhering thereto;
13	(3)	[Any] Except for ferrets or unless allowed elsewhere
14		in this chapter, any live snake, flying fox, fruit
15		bat, Gila monster, injurious insect, or eels of the
16		order Anguilliformes, or any other animal, plant, or
17		microorganism in any stage of development that is
18		detrimental or potentially harmful to agriculture,

horticulture, animal or public health, or natural
resources, including native biota, or has an adverse
effect on the environment as determined by the board,
[except, as provided in this chapter and] provided
that, notwithstanding the list of animals prohibited
entry into the State, the department may bring into
and maintain in the State four live, sterile brown
tree snakes of the male sex for the purpose of
research or training of snake detector dogs, and,
further, that a government agency may bring into and
maintain in the State not more than two live,
nonvenomous snakes of the male sex solely for the
purpose of exhibition in a government zoo, but only
after:
(A) The board is presented with satisfactory evidenc
that the sex of the snakes was established to be
male prior to the shipment; and

- The board gives written approval conditioned upon (B) such terms as the board may deem necessary, which terms shall include measures to assure the prevention of escape, continuing supervision and control by the board with respect to any

2		manner in which the snakes shall be disposed of
3		or destroyed.
4		In case of the death of one or more snakes, the
5		department or government agency may import and
6		maintain replacements subject to the conditions
7		described in this paragraph; and
8	(4)	Any live or dead honey bees, or used bee equipment
9		that is not certified by the department to be free of
10		pests; provided that nothing in this paragraph shall
11		be construed to prohibit the importation of bee
12		semen."
