A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PLANNED COMMUNITY ASSOCIATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 421J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§421J- Delivery of declarations and association
5	documents to prospective purchaser; right to cancel. (a) Upon
6	the execution of a sales contract for the purchase of property
7	in a planned community, the seller shall provide the prospective
8	purchaser with copies of the declaration and association
9	documents, as amended, as those terms are defined in section
10	421J-2, and receive a receipt from the prospective purchaser
11	with a complete list of all documents delivered.
12	(b) Within fifteen days of the date of the receipt, the
13	prospective purchaser may cancel the sales contract, without
14	cause, upon the delivery of a written notice to cancel the sales
15	contract. Delivery shall be in person or by post, return
16	receipt requested. Upon a timely cancellation, the sale
17	contract shall be void and of no further force or effect, and
18	the prospective purchaser shall receive any deposit the

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- 1 prospective purchaser made pursuant to the sales contract, less
- 2 any reasonable escrow fee accrued."
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun, before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
