A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 342G-101, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending the definition of "deposit beverage container" to read as follows:
- 4 ""Deposit beverage container" means [the] an individual,
- 5 separate, sealed glass, polyethylene terephthalte, high density
- 6 polyethylene, or metal container that is less than or equal to
- 7 [sixty-four] sixty-eight fluid ounces $[\tau]$ and used for
- 8 containing, at the time of sale to the consumer, a deposit
- 9 beverage intended for use or consumption in this State."
- 10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
