A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there is a lack of hospitals and health centers in the southern portion of the island of Hawaii, and residents of the area are particularly vulnerable in the event of a serious medical emergency. The most efficient solution is to provide two emergency mobile urgent care units to be stationed at the fire departments in the communities of Ocean View and Volcano.

The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
department of health to develop a pilot program in cooperation
with emergency medical services, fire departments, the Hawaii
health systems corporation, and community clinics to provide the
people of the southern portion of the island of Hawaii with
increased access to appropriate emergency and urgent medical
care.
