A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE FISH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The humuhumunukunukuapua a (rhinecanthus
2	rectangulus), also known as the rectangular triggerfish, was
3	designated as the official fish of the State in 1985. However,
4	the enabling legislation was automatically repealed by operation
5	of law in 1990, five years after the date of approval. Many
6	among the general public, however, mistakenly assume that the
7	humuhumunukunukuapua'a is still the state fish. The legislature
8	finds that Hawaii does not currently have a fish designated as
9	the official fish of the State.
10	The purpose of this Act is to permanently establish the
11	humuhumunukunukuapua'a as the official fish of the State.
12	SECTION 2. Chapter 5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
13	by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
14	read as follows:
15	"§5- State fish. The humuhumunukunukuapua a
16	(rhinecanthus rectangulus), also known as the rectangular
17	triggerfish, is established and designated as the official fish
18	of the State."
