### A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 6 SECTION 4. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
- 7 department of education for the purposes of this Act.
