A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO A DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL DEFENSE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to direct the transition to the establishment of a new department of civil 2 defense to which all powers, responsibilities, and functions 3 currently assumed by the state department of defense in the 4 areas of civil defense, disaster relief, and emergency planning, 5 preparedness, and response shall be transferred. 6 SECTION 2. Section 26-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 7 8 amended to read as follows: "\$26-4 Structure of government. Under the supervision of 9 the governor, all executive and administrative offices, 10 departments, and instrumentalities of the state government and 11 their respective functions, powers, and duties shall be 12 allocated among and within the following principal departments 13 that are hereby established: 14 Department of human resources development (Section 15 (1)26 - 5) 16 Department of accounting and general services (Section 17 (2) 18 26-6)

SECTION 3. During the interim period before the 2007 1 legislative session the governor shall prepare an organizational 2 and functional plan for the new department and a plan for the 3 orderly transition of the functions transferred by this Act. 4 The governor shall be assisted by a task force appointed by the 5 governor, consisting of representatives of the state department 6 of defense, the civil defense advisory council, the office of 7 disaster relief, the civil defense agency of each county, the 8 citizen's advisory commission on civil defense, and the United 9 States Departments of Defense and Homeland Security. 10 organizational and functional plan, including any necessary 11 proposed legislation, shall be submitted to the legislature no 12 later than thirty days prior to the convening of the 2007 13 regular session as part of the executive budget request. 14 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 16 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval 17 and shall be repealed on July 1, 2007, in the event that the 18 legislature fails to enact a law establishing the powers, 19 duties, and other provisions of the department of civil defense 20
