A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
2	for a fully-capable, advanced life support emergency medical
3	services ambulance unit that would provide sixteen-hours-a-day,
4	seven-days-a-week emergency response service to the areas of
5	Lower Mililani, Waipio Gentry, Waikele, Crestview, East Waipahu,
6	Waiawa, and the Pearl City industrial area on Oahu, to be
7	stationed in the Waipio Gentry area.
8	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
9	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
10	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 to be
11	deposited into the emergency medical services special fund.
12	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the emergency
13	medical services special fund the sum of \$, or so much
14	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 to
15	establish a fully-capable, advanced life support emergency
16	medical services ambulance unit, stationed in the Waipio Gentry
17	area, that would provide sixteen-hours-a-day, seven-days-a-week
18	emergency response service to the areas of Lower Mililani,

- 1 Waipio Gentry, Waikele, Crestview, East Waipahu, Waiawa, and the
- 2 Pearl City industrial area on Oahu.
- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 4 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
