6	The	report shall include:
7	(1)	How the agency is using each of the strategies
8		described in this part to help meet energy and
9		greenhouse gas reduction goals;
10	(2)	A listing and explanation as to why certain
11		strategies, if any, have not been used; provided that
12		for each energy product acquired by the agency that is
13		not an ENERGY STAR product or other energy efficient
14		product, as set forth in section 196-23(a), the agency
15		shall include an explanation as to why an ENERGY STAR
16		or other energy efficient product was not selected;
17		and
18	(3)	A listing and explanation of exempt facilities."
