A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COUNTIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 1 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to 3 read as follows: "§46- Residential property tax discount program; 4 authority to establish. (a) A county may establish a 5 6 residential property tax discount program that provides residential real property taxpayers with a discount on their 7 property taxes based upon the number of years a residential real 8 property taxpayer has resided in the State and filed a State of 9 Hawaii income tax return. A county may establish procedures and 10 qualifications to participate in its real property tax discount 11 program and determine the amount of the discount; provided that 12 any discount program established by a county shall only apply to 13 the real property tax upon the residential real property in 14 15 which the real property taxpayer resides. (b) A real property tax discount program shall be 16 established by ordinance of the legislative body of the 17 18 respective county."
