A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION ELECTRICITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
- 2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.
- 4 SECTION 2. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
- 5 to fund the cost of the department of education's electricity
- 6 usage. Increasing usage and cost of electricity has created a
- 7 critical funding emergency for fiscal year 2005-2006. The
- 8 department of education will not have sufficient funds to pay
- 9 for electricity with the current appropriation amount. An
- 10 emergency appropriation is needed to fund the program for the
- 11 first year of the biennium.
- 12 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$4,908,748, or so
- 14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2005-2006, for
- 15 the purposes of this Act.
- 16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 17 education.

1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
