.. TITLE:

A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HOUSING FUNDS.

PURPOSE:

To require the legislature to provide a declaration of findings and purposes setting forth the other purposes for which housing funds are being appropriated, transferred, or lapses, when the housing funds are used for purposes other than those established for each fund in statute. The measure will also require a two-thirds majority vote of the legislature to approve the transfer or lapse of specified housing funds when they are used for other purposes; and the measure will allow the Hawaii public housing administration and the Hawaii housing finance and development administration to transfer funds between programs.

MEANS:

Add a new section to Chapter 201G, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION:

Since 1995, \$208,870,984.66 has been raided from the housing funds: State Low Income Housing Revolving Fund; Teacher Housing Revolving Fund; Housing for Elders Revolving Fund; Housing Finance Revolving Fund; Kikala-Keokea Revolving Fund; Rental Assistance Revolving Fund; Dwelling Unit Revolving Fund; Rental Housing Trust Fund; and the Fee Simple Residential Revolving Fund.

The steady depletion of these nine housing funds, through raids and transfers, has caused the public trust and confidence in the availability and administration of these funds to wane. Due to this uncertainty, developers are hesitant to enter into agreements with the HCDCH to develop affordable housing and affordable housing rental units.

Impact on the public: Increased confidence in the availability of housing funds.
