A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LOANS FOR HEALTH PROFESSIONALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§321- Loans to health professionals; rural areas;
5	rural area health professionals loan fund. (a) The department
6	of health shall establish a loan program to provide interest-
7	free home purchase loans to qualified health professionals.
8	(b) The department may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91
9	to establish eligibility requirements for health professionals
10	applying for a loan under this section.
11	(c) Loans made under this section shall be interest-free
12	and used by the qualified health professional exclusively for
13	the purchase of homes, including apartments, townhouses, and
14	condominiums. In addition, loans made under this section shall
15	be:
16	(1) Repaid with a payment plan specified by the
17	department; provided that additional payments in any

1		sums, or the payment of the entire principal, may be			
2		made at any date within the time period of the loan;			
3	<u>(2)</u>	Secured in a manner to be determined by the			
4		department; and			
5	<u>(3)</u>	Subject to penalties for delinquency or late payments			
6		as specified by the department and including			
7		subsection (d).			
8	The department shall negotiate the terms and conditions of each				
9	loan to e	ensure that each loan complies with the provisions of			
10	this section.				
11	(d) During the time period of the loan, if at any time a				
12	person receiving the loan fails to comply with the requirements				
13	established in the definition of "qualified health professional"				
14	under this section, the loan shall be considered forfeit and all				
15	principal amounts outstanding, plus penalties, shall become due				
16	and payab	le. If the principal amounts outstanding and penalties			
17	are not r	are not remitted, the department may initiate foreclosure			
18	proceedin	gs on the home purchased through the proceeds from the			
19	loan. Th	is section shall not apply in cases where the qualified			
20	health professional fails to comply with the requirements				
21	because of circumstances beyond the qualified health				
22	professio	nal's control, as determined by the department.			

1	(e) Loans provided under this section shall not exceed
2	<pre>\$ per qualified health professional. Each qualified</pre>
3	health professional shall receive no more than one loan under
4	this section.
5	(f) There is established in the state treasury a special
6	fund to be known as the rural area health professionals loan
7	fund. Moneys in this fund shall be loaned by the department
8	pursuant to this section. The rural area health professionals
9	loan fund shall be funded by:
10	(1) Legislative appropriations;
11	(2) Federal funds if available; and
12	(3) All principal payments, fees, penalties, and any other
13	proceeds derived by the department pursuant to this
14	section.
15	(g) For the purposes of this section:
16	"Qualified health professional" means a licensed physician
17	or an advance practice registered nurse working at least forty
18	hours per week in a qualified rural area health facility who
19	fulfills the eligibility requirements, if any, specified under
20	subsection (b).
21	"Qualified rural health facility" means a public or private
22	hospital, medical clinic, or physician's office that:

1	<u>(1)</u>	Has demonstrated difficulty in hiring and retaining		
2		licensed physicians or advanced practice registered		
3		nurses, according to standards and criteria specified		
4		by the department; and		
5	<u>(2)</u>	Is located in a rural area that is characterized by a		
6		<pre>low population density and the absence of "city-like"</pre>		
7		concentration of structures, streets, and urban		
8		services; provided that the department may establish		
9		more specific criteria and standards to further define		
10		"rural area"."		
11	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general			
12	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much			
13	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 to be			
14	deposited into the rural area health professionals loan fund.			
15	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of			
16	budget and finance for the purposes of this Act.			
17	SECT	ION 3. There is appropriated out of the rural area		
18	health pr	ofessionals loan fund the sum of \$ or so much		
19	thereof a	s may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 to be used		
20	for the purposes of the fund.			
21	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of			
22	health for the purposes of this Act.
