BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

Section 708-893, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows: "(1) A person commits the offense of use of a computer in 3 the commission of a separate crime if the person either 4 5 intentionally uses a computer to obtain control over the property of the victim or knowingly uses a computer to identify, 6 7 select, solicit, persuade, coerce, entice, induce, or procure 8 the victim or intended victim of the following offenses: 9 (a) Section 707-726, relating to custodial interference in 10 the first degree; 11 (b) Section 707-727, relating to custodial interference in 12 the second degree; 13 Section 707-731, relating to sexual assault in the (C) 14 second degree; Section 707-732, relating to sexual assault in the 15 (d) 16 third degree; 17 Section 707-733, relating to sexual assault in the (e) 18 fourth degree;
