Section 708-893, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows: "(1) A person commits the offense of use of a computer in 3 the commission of a separate crime if the person [knowingly]: 4 Intentionally uses a computer to obtain control over 5 (a) the property of the victim to commit theft in the 6 7 first or second degree; or Knowingly uses a computer to identify, select, 8 (b) solicit, persuade, coerce, entice, induce, or procure 9 10 the victim or intended victim of the following offenses: 11 (i) Section 707-726, relating to custodial 12 [(a)] interference in the first degree; 13 (ii) Section 707-727, relating to custodial 14 [-(b)-] interference in the second degree; 15 (iii) Section 707-731, relating to sexual assault in 16 [-(c)-] 17 the second degree;

Amends offense of use of a computer in the commission of a separate crime by including use of a computer to obtain control over the property of the victim or to facilitate commission of the offense of theft in the first or second degrees. (SD2)
