A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR INCREASING STIPENDS FOR VOLUNTEER PRECINCT OFFICIALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that precinct officials
- 2 have not been given stipend increases for over sixteen years.
- 3 This fact, along with the dwindling number of names submitted by
- 4 political parties, has adversely affected the recruitment of
- 5 precinct officials. As a result, polling sites often operate
- 6 with less than one hundred per cent staffing, thereby lowering
- 7 the level of service to voters.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation to
- 9 allow the chief election officer to increase precinct official
- 10 stipends.
- 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$96,542 or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 to
- 14 increase precinct official stipends.
- 15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of
- 16 elections through the department of accounting and general

- 1 services for the purposes of this Act.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
