A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FAMILY VISITS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that families are a
2	resource to offenders during their incarceration. The support
3	of family members can also play a key role in an offender's
4	rehabilitation, transition, and successful re-entry from prison
5	or jail to the community. By bringing together an offender and
6	an offender's family through positive, consistent, and mutually
7	desirable contact, the correctional system will be improving
8	public safety and strengthening communities.
9	The purpose of this Act is to ensure the right of family
10	members to visit inmates.
11	SECTION 2. Chapter 353, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
12	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
13	and to read as follows:
14	"§353- Visits from family members. (a) Family members
1 =	

- shall be allowed to visit an inmate at any state correctional
 facility during official visiting hours.
- (b) A visit from a family member shall be preapproved and
- 18 prescheduled. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary,



- 1 preapproved and prescheduled visits for which family members
- 2 have incurred substantial costs, including but not limited to
- 3 travel from a neighbor island or the mainland, shall not be
- 4 cancelled due to staff absenteeism or any non-emergency
- 5 situation. In the event that there are insufficient numbers of
- 6 security staff available to maintain the safety of the facility,
- 7 these visits shall be conducted in a non-contact setting.
- 8 (c) The department shall develop internal policies and
- 9 procedures consistent with this section.
- (d) For the purposes of this section, "family members"
- 11 means persons who are related to each other by blood, marriage,
- 12 adoption, or legal quardianship."
- 13 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
- 15 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, to
- 16 the department of public safety for the purpose of retrofitting
- 17 facilities with non-contact visitation areas.
- 18 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 19 public safety for the purposes of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 21 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.

Report Title:

Corrections; Family Visits

Description:

Restricts the department of public safety from canceling preapproved and prescheduled family visits with inmates in cases where the family has incurred substantial costs. Provides that if a visit cannot take place based upon a lack of available security staff, the visit shall take place in a non-contact setting. Appropriates funds. (SD2)
