A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HOMELESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The State is required by the Department of Housing and Urban Development to provide accurate and updated 2 information every two years on the prevalence of Hawaii's 3 homeless population. A census of Hawaii's homeless residents 4 was completed in the years 2003 and 2005. The biennial census 5 has provided information on the extent, characteristics, and 6 7 causes of homelessness. 8 It is anticipated that the Department of Housing and Urban Development will mandate communities to begin performing a 9 yearly census. The completion of an annual census of persons 10 11 who are homeless will help to ensure competitiveness in 12 receiving funds from the Department of Housing and Urban 13 Development. Information on population estimates, geographic distribution, ethnic composition, needs assessment, and 14 15 identification of key populations will be valuable in securing related federal funding targeted at homeless sub-populations, 16 including veterans, ex-offenders, and children. - 1 homeless services funding from private sources, as well as 2 evaluating progress on reducing homelessness in Hawaii. 3 SECTION 2. Chapter 201G-432, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 4 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows: 5 The fund shall be used to provide loans or grants for "(d) 6 the development, pre-development, construction, acquisition, 7 preservation, and substantial rehabilitation of rental housing units.
