A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE PLANNING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. During the 2005 special session, the 2 legislature adopted Act 8, which created the Hawaii 2050 3 sustainability task force (task force) to review the Hawaii state plan and the State's planning process, and required the 4 5 office of the auditor to prepare the Hawaii 2050 sustainability 6 plan. Once all of the members of the task force were appointed, 7 the task force held several meetings during the fall of 2005. 8 The objectives of these meetings were to address and meet the 9 10 requirements of Act 8, Special Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, and 11 to develop and approve a process to create the Hawaii 2050 12 sustainability plan. Based on these objectives, the task force 13 submitted a report to the legislature outlining the process for 14 creating the plan and making additional recommendations. In its recommendations, the task force noted that after 15 16 reviewing the magnitude of creating the sustainability plan, more time is required to perform necessary research and 17

community outreach. The purpose of this Act is to extend:

The task force's deadline for completing the Hawaii 1 (1)2050 sustainability plan by one year; and 2 3 (2) The authority of the task force to June 30, 2008. SECTION 2. Act 8, Special Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, is 4 amended by amending section 4 to read as follows: 5 "SECTION 4. Hawaii 2050 sustainability plan. (a) After 6 7 receipt of the task force's report, the office of the auditor shall prepare the Hawaii 2050 sustainability plan. The plan 8 shall be prepared to define and implement state goals, 9 objectives, policies, and priority guidelines using sections 10 11 226-3 to 226-27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as guiding principles. The auditor shall seek input from all state departments. 12 auditor shall also solicit public views and concerns in 13 preparation of the plan and shall incorporate all or a portion 14 15 of the recommendations reported by the Hawaii 2050 task force. The plan shall serve as a quideline for funding and 16 implementation by state and county agencies. The office of 17 planning shall assist the auditor in reviewing the plan. 18 The auditor shall submit the sustainability plan to 19 (b) the legislature no later than twenty days before the convening 20

- 1 (c) The auditor, with the assistance of the office of
- 2 planning, shall update the plan every ten years and report to
- 3 the legislature."
- 4 SECTION 3. Act 8, Special Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, is
- 5 amended by amending section 7 to read as follows:
- 6 "SECTION 7. The Hawaii 2050 task force shall cease to
- 7 operate after [the adjournment sine die of the 2007 regular
- 8 session of the legislature. June 30, 2008."
- 9 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
