Any creditor collecting money under garnishment 12 process shall furnish duplicate receipts therefor to the 13 garnishee, one of which receipts shall be delivered by the 14 garnishee to the debtor. 15 No portion of any salary or wages withheld or sequestered 16 shall be paid to any creditor unless such duplicate receipts are 17 delivered to the person in whose hands the funds are sequestered 18 or withheld, and any creditor failing to furnish such duplicate 19 receipts shall forfeit any amounts taken without the furnishing 20 by the creditor of the duplicate receipts, and the creditor 21 shall be personally liable, to debtor, for the amounts."] 22 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 23

and stricken.
