A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THEFT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 708-832, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§708-832 Theft in the third degree. (1) A person commits the offense of theft in the third degree if the person 4 5 commits theft: Of property or services the value of which exceeds 6 (a) 7 \$100; [or] 8 (b) Of gasoline, diesel fuel or other related petroleum 9 products used as propellants of any value not 10 exceeding \$200; 11 Of a person's mail, irrespective of monetary value; or (c) 12 (d) Possession of another person's mail where the 13 possessor does not reside at the address of the 14 intended recipient of the mail. 15 (2) Theft in the third degree is a misdemeanor. 16 (3) For purposes of this section, the theft or possession 17 of an individual's mail shall be treated as one charge of theft in the third degree. If a person commits theft of mail from 18

- 1 multiple individuals, the theft of mail from each individual
- 2 shall represent a charge of theft in the third degree. Theft or
- 3 possession of mail, under subparagraphs (1)(c) or (1)(d), from
- 4 three or more individuals in a one year period shall constitute
- 5 a class C felony. Subsequent violations of subparagraphs (1)(c)
- 6 and (1)(d) within a ten year period from the conviction of the
- 7 previous offense shall be a class C felony."
- 8 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
