## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 708-836.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"[§708-836.5] Unauthorized entry into motor vehicle.
4	$\left[\frac{(1)}{(1)}\right]$ (a) A person commits the offense of unauthorized entry
5	into motor vehicle if:
6	(1) the person intentionally or knowingly enters or
7	remains unlawfully in a motor vehicle with the
8	intent to commit a crime against a person or
9	against property rights; or
10	(2) the person intentionally or knowingly enters or
11	remains unlawfully in a motor vehicle without the
12	permission of the registered owner.
13	[ <del>(2)</del> ] <u>(b)</u> Unauthorized entry into motor vehicle <u>under</u>
14	subparagraph (a)(1) is a class C felony. Unauthorized entry into
15	motor vehicle under subparagraph (a)(2) is a misdemeanor.
16	Subsequent violations of subparagraph (a)(2) within a ten year
17	period from the conviction of the previous offense shall be a
18	class C felony."
