RELATING TO SMALL BOAT HARBORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 200-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"(b) In order to obtain a permit or a permit renewal, the
4	owner of a vessel shall provide, at the owner's own expense:
5	(1) A marine surveyor's inspection no more than two years
6	old, or a vessel inspection report no more than two
7	years old completed by the United States Coast Guard
8	or an inspector approved by the department, certifying
9	that the surveyor, the United States Coast Guard, or
10	approved inspector has inspected the vessel and
11	considers it to fulfill the requirements set by the
12	department; and
13	(2) Documentation that the person is the owner of the
14	vessel. The documentation shall meet requirements
15	established by the department."
16	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
17	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Gives a vessel owner seeking a permit or permit renewal for mooring in small boat harbors the option of providing: (1) a marine surveyor's inspection; or (2) a vessel inspection report that is no more than two years old completed by the U.S. Coast Guard or an approved inspector. (HB2926 HD1)
