A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELDERLY IDENTIFICATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The kupuna ID project was initiated on a 2 volunteer basis by the department of the attorney general and 3 its law enforcement partners to help elderly adults, who may 4 become disoriented, sick, or lost, by providing them with an 5 identification card that includes their photo, name and 6 emergency contact information. The card assists emergency 7 personnel to identify a lost senior citizen and to contact 8 appropriate responsible parties. Limited resources forced the 9 closure of this popular program. 10 The executive office on aging's SageWatch program has 11 offered to adopt the kupuna ID project as part of its outreach 12 activities. Volunteers will be trained by the department of the 13 attorney general. The goals include partnering with the 14 community to implement the program statewide, coordinating 15 community events across the State for kupuna to register and be 16 photographed, and creating a central database for information 17 that may be accessible to necessary authorities and family 18 members in the event that a kupuna is lost or missing. - 3 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys for the
- 4 executive office on aging's SageWatch program to adopt the
- 5 kupuna ID project as part of its outreach activities, including
- 6 the funding of two positions, program specialist IV (SR 22) and
- 7 program specialist III (SR 20).
- 8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$120,116, or so much
- 10 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for the
- 11 executive office on aging's SageWatch program to adopt the
- 12 kupuna ID project as part of its outreach activities, including
- 13 the funding of two positions, program specialist IV (SR 22) and
- 14 program specialist III (SR 20).
- 15 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
- 16 department of health for the purposes of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
